

## Conditions of Entry for Caboolture Event

1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these Conditions of Entry. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Conditions of Entry.

Entry is only open to Australian residents (excluding NSW residents) aged between 7 and 15 years inclusive who, with the consent of their parent or guardian, fully complete the registration, including making full payment, to participate in the Caboolture 'Weet-Bix Kids TRYathlon 2012' series event.
